

OAU POLICY ON THE APPROPRIATE USE OF THE HALLS OF RESIDENCE

- (i) A STUDENT shall not obtain accommodation by fraudulent means.
- (ii) A STUDENT shall not sell to, or buy accommodation from another STUDENT
- (iii) A STUDENT shall not harbour non-students in allocated rooms
- (iv) A STUDENT shall not secure multiple accommodation allocations one or more halls of residence.
- (v) A STUDENT shall not harbour squatters in the halls of residence.
- (vi) A STUDENT shall not use prohibited electrical appliances or tamper with electrical installations in the halls of residence
- (vii) A STUDENT shall not by any action or inaction damage or destroy university property in the halls of residence
- (viii) A STUDENT shall not move any university property from one hall to another without proper authorization
- (ix) A STUDENT shall not organise parties or social events which may disrupting general peace in the rooms within the halls of residence
- (x) A STUDENT shall not engage in any disorderly conduct in the Halls of residence

NB: Policy violation is punishable by loss of studentship!!
